How to Calculate MPSD Rankings

Re: #387 / 420 (bottom 8%)

1. Visit the DPI website, <https://apps2.dpi.wi.gov/reportcards/>
2. Under "NEED DOWNLOADABLE REPORT CARD DATA?"
 - a. Click "DISTRICT REPORT CARD DATA DOWNLOADABLE FILE" under year 20-21. This will open in Excel.
3. When the file is open click the DATA tab at the bottom of the file (This should be the 4th tab from the left)
4. Find the column "OVERALL ACCOUNTABILITY SCORE" (this should be Column F)
 - a. Click on the 2nd row in this column and right click and sort largest to smallest
 - b. **Note that the 'Sort' function in Excel can be found under the Data heading**
5. You'll find that there are 421 districts (I removed one district since scores were listed as N/A)
6. You'll also find that Manitowoc when sorting best scores to worst in the state is #387 out of 420 districts with an Overall Accountability Score of 59.8.
 - a. $387/420 = .9214$ (92% of schools scored better on DPI testing)
 - b. $1.0 - .9214 = .0785$ or **BOTTOM 8%**
